## Certified in Dental Infection Prevention and Control (CDIPC®) Certification

### Requirements

There are education and experience requirements to apply for the CDIPC exam. This is the main pathway to earn CDIPC certification, with several education and experience options available.

#### EDUCATION

Complete one of the following options.

Pass DANB's ICE exam within the last 5 years or currently hold CDA, COA, NELDA, or DISIPC certification	Complete steps one and two.
