## Dental Industry Specialist in Infection Prevention and Control (DISIPC®) Certification



### Requirements

There are education and experience requirements to apply for the DISIPC exam. This is the main pathway to earn DISIPC certification, with several education and experience options available.

#### EDUCATION

Complete steps one and two. You only need to select one option from step two.

1. Hold the [Dental Infection Prevention and Control Certificate™](#) **AND**
2. Complete **one** of the education options:

  - b. [From Policy to Practice: ADS's Guide to the CDC Guidelines](#) **OR**

  - e. Graduate from a Commission on Dental Accreditation (CODA)-accredited dental assisting or dental laboratory technology program **OR**
  - f. Hold an associate degree or higher in a dental, healthcare, life sciences or applied life sciences field

Complete at least 1,040 hours of work experience as a dental practice manager, dental sales professional, or dental inspector/investigator
